Let's **[G]** start at the very beginning

A **[G]** very good place to start

When you **[F]** read you begin with **[C]** A-B-C

When you **[F]** sing you be-**[C]**gin with do-re-mi

**[C]** Do-re-mi, do-re-mi

The **[G]** first three **[F]** notes just **[C]** happen to be

**[C]** Do-re-mi, do-re-mi

**[C]** Do-re-**[F]** mi-fa-**[C]** so-la-**[G]** ti

**[NC]** (spoken) Let's see if I can make it easier

**[C]** Doe, a deer, a female deer

**[G7]** Ray, a drop of golden sun

**[C]** Me, a name I call myself

**[G7]** Far, a long, long way to run

**[C]** Sew, a needle pulling **[F]** thread

**[D7]** La, a note to follow **[G7]** Sew

**[E7]** Tea, a drink with jam and **[Am]** bread **[C7]**

That will **[F]** bring us **[G]** back to **[C]** Do (oh-oh-oh)

(Repeat above verse twice)

**[C]** Do-re-mi-**[F]** fa-so-la-ti-**[C]** do-**[G]** so-**[C]** do!
